

## ADAP Information

Beginning January 1, 2013 students are able to self-register for the eADAP program. Gwinnett Online Campus has offered all students the following information on how to obtain their ADAP certificate. The student takes this course independently from our Health course and must remember to SAVE their certificate and print it if they want to obtain a Georgia Driver's License before the age of 18. The teacher will not have access to the student's account due to the student taking this online version of ADAP independently from the Health course. - Choose the option: **My School Does Not Offer ADAP**
- Enter all your information, and be sure to provide an email address that you use **regularly AND that you will remember in case you lose your certificate (it becomes your USER ID)**. This is where you will receive all the information for taking the course. Once you receive the email you will have 30 days to complete the course.
- On this link you also have a link to **print out a certificate** that you may have lost, as well as other frequently asked questions (**NOTE: If you were an eADAP student prior to January 1, 2013 while taking Online Health with us be sure to use your GOC email you had for the course as your USERID.
